A few weeks before his departure for the 1984 Olympic Games in Los Angeles it happened: artistic gymnast Andreas Japtok pushed out his right elbow with his right knee during a flight element on the horizontal bar. Were four years of hard training for nothing? But Japtok braces himself against the Olympics, can be treated for ten days and stabilize his elbow. Three and a half weeks later, the Hanoverian competed in his first Olympic competition, finished fourth with the team and finished 17th in the all-around. In addition to participating in the Olympics, Japtok counts fifth place with the team at the 1985 World Championships and, last but not least, the German All-Around Championships in 1987 among his greatest successes. Between 1978 and 1989, the multiple German champion took part in five world championships, two European championships and many international tournaments.

He has always wanted to „understand“ the body – and over the years he has developed a special soft spot for muscle and joint functions. His specialty is shoulder and Achilles tendon injuries. In addition to dealing with people, what he loves most about his job is „that you can achieve a lot with little effort – and an operation is not always the panacea.“ to be able to alleviate.

As a sports physician, Andreas Japtok has remained true to competitive sport: For more than ten years, he has looked after the squad and competitive athletes at the Olympic base in Hanover, the ice hockey players of the “Hanover Indians” and “Hannover Scorpions” and the Bundesliga team of the Lower Saxony gymnastics team. Since 2004, the former artistic gymnast has also been the tour doctor of the „Fireworks of Gymnastics“.

Andreas Japtok studied medicine in Hamburg and Hanover (exam 1990). After completing his training at the Agnes-Karll-Hospital in Laatzen, he built up the sports medicine department there from 1996 and is a specialist in surgery, orthopedics and accident surgery as well as an accident insurance doctor – and has been in practice since 2005. His additional training: acupuncture according to Yamamoto, FDM (fascial distortion model according to Typaldos), A diploma in applied kinesiology. Krebschirurgie

Umfasst alle Operationen an Speiseröhre, Magen, Leber, Bauchspeicheldrüse, Darm und Mastdarm, aber auch an der Schilddrüse und Weichteiltumoren

Schlüssellochoperationen

Gallenblase, Blinddarm, Leistenbruch, Zwerchfellbruch, Bauchdeckenbruch, Nebennierentumoren und entzündete Darmabschnitte werden regelhaft mit dieser Technik operiert. Krebserkrankungen im Bereich des Darms werden häufig und zunehmend auf diese Weise operiert.

Schilddrüsenchirurgie

Schilddrüsenkrebs und Kröpfe werden nach modernen Standards in guter Kooperation mit den niedergelassenen Nuklearmedizinern und Hausärzten operiert.

Diabetische Füße und Extremitäten

In Kooperation mit den Diabetologen werden Extremitäten mit schlechter Durchblutung möglichst Extremitäten erhaltend operiert. Die dazu benötigte große Erfahrung wird durch spezialisierte Chirurgen und Internisten gewährleistet.

Proktologie

Sehr viele Menschen leiden an Hämorrhoiden oder anderen Erkrankungen im Analsbereich. Auch hier besteht eine Spezialisierung mit mehreren speziell ausgebildeten Chirurgen zur Verfügung

Die besondere Kennzeichnung von Professor Schumacher und damit auch des Städtischen Klinikums Braunschweig ist die enge Zusammenarbeit mit Ärzten anderer Abteilungen, anderer Krankenhäuser und niedergelassenen Ärzten.

Alle Patienten mit bösartigen Erkrankungen werden im Rahmen des Cancer Centers Braunschweig

in Zusammenarbeit mit Spezialisten aller beteiligten Abteilungen sowie niedergelassenen Ärzten behandelt. Die Spezialisten, die an den wöchentlichen Konferenzen teilnehmen und gemeinsam die Behandlung jedes Patienten diskutieren und beschließen sind Chirurgen, Gastroenterologen, Onkologen, Radioonkologen, Radiologen, Pathologen und niedergelassene Onkologen. Bei Patienten, die für die Therapieentscheidung weitere Spezialisten benötigen, nehmen diese im Einzelfall ebenfalls teil. So sind z.B. die Kinderärzte bei Minderjährigen mit bösartigen Erkrankungen eng mit einbezogen.

Bei Patienten mit speziellen gutartigen, jedoch komplexen Erkrankungen, wie es bei den chronisch entzündlichen Darmerkrankungen der Fall ist, sind wiederum andere Spezialisten beteiligt. Dies sind neben den Chirurgen die Gastroenterologen und häufig spezialisierte Kinderärzte.

Jedes Organ und jede OP-Technik wird von einem besonderen Kompetenzteam betreut, so dass für jeden Patienten die höchste Qualität der Behandlung sicher gestellt werden kann.
